

ORDINANCE NO. 14-22

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 6 CHAPTER 2 SECTION 3
RE: COMPASSIONATE USE OF MEDICINAL CANNABIS**

WHEREAS, the Morton Municipal Code was adopted on March 2, 1970, and duly published in book form; and

WHEREAS, the legislature has passed The Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act and as a result certain exceptions apply to the possession of cannabis; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to modify the ordinance regarding possession of cannabis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MORTON, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT TITLE 6, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 3 OF THE MORTON MUNICIPAL CODE IS AMENDED BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING:

A qualifying patient who has a registry identification card or a registered caregiver who does not possess an amount in excess of what is allowed under The Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act is exempt from the above provisions. A qualifying patient and registry identification card are defined in the Act.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as may be required by law.
