**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING COURTLAND STREET AND
MAIN STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees desire to support the reconstruction of Courtland Street and Main Street, which is described as follows:

The proposed project includes auxiliary turn lanes, curb and gutter, traffic signal upgrades, and a ten foot asphalt shared use path. The improvements will start at the intersection of Main Street and Courtland Street heading westerly towards North Morton Avenue. The proposed improvements will complete the Courtland Street corridor by matching into the ongoing Courtland Street improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEE OF THE VILLAGE OF MORTON, Tazewell County, Illinois as follows:
