Gas Meter Change Program

The Village of Morton Gas Department changes meters annually in the distribution system. The frequency of changes is as follows:

Small residential meters every 20-30 years

Mid-sized meters every 10 years

Large meters every 5 years

> As of 2017, there are 6,100 meters in the system

A Village of Morton Gas employee will try to contact you when your meter is due for changing. If you receive a note on your door, please call in promptly and schedule a time for the meter change. Only trained and qualified Village of Morton Gas employees will do the work of replacing gas meters. Employees carry Village of Morton ID's.

When replacing a gas meter, the gas <u>will</u> have to be <u>shut-off</u>. The customer will have to be at home in order to relight gas appliances. This process usually takes less than 20 minutes.

Note: The Village will make every attempt to safeguard the customer, and put into service the appliances. The Village provides gas to the appliance and <u>is not</u> liable for the operation of the appliance after the work is performed. Municipal code 8-2-19.
