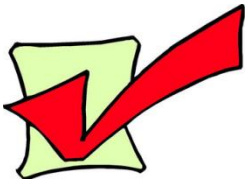


CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR ACT
(Illinois Public Act 094-0741)

Law was in effect, January 01, 2007... Every dwelling must be equipped with a carbon monoxide (CO) detector located within 15 feet of every room used for sleeping.

This law applies to every Illinois property owner (including personal residences) that use fossil fuels (natural gas, wood, etc.) and/or have attached garages.



REMEMBER.... To check and replace batteries
in CO and Smoke Detectors
(Over 90 percent of all CO Calls are from low or dead batteries)



A good habit to change batteries in Carbon Monoxide and Smoke Detectors each Spring and Fall when you change time on your clocks.
