- Julie Smick presented the treasurer's report. There were no actionable items. Motion to approve by Wirth, 2nd by Schaffnit -motion CARRIED
- IFPPA has submitted a bill for annual dues of \$795. Motion to approve by Wirth, 2nd by Schaffnit, voice vote Wirth Y, Darche Y, Brock Y, Schaffnit Y. Motion CARRIED.
- Officer Andrew Kolvec has retired from MPD as of August 13, 2018, with 27 years and 10 days of service. His pension is calculated at \$4315.25/month.
- Heartland Bank: The 3 representatives provided an hour of details of how their investment service may benefit us. Most interesting was their significantly lower fees, which would translate to a \$20,000/year savings to the fund (1/3rd lower than current fees). We will table this and decide at next meeting.
- A question arose regarding mandated equities/bonds ratio for our investments. The statute reads 55/45, but we had a letter implying that 65/35 is allowed. Hopefully Julie Smick will be able to provide a copy of this letter for our files.
- Julie Smick advises that we are required to provide certificates of our continuing education from the period of 5-2017 to present. Please email directly to Julie if you have certificates.
